Policy Proposals:

- **Tackling mental health through sport:**
 - Organising a weekly/fortnightly 5-a-side football game open to all
- **More non-drinking events-**
 - Working closely with the Ents executive to get more non-drinking events going
 - The Great Fitzish Bake Off! - for charity
 - Working alongside the Fitz Art Soc- casual, week 5 drawing starting next term
- **Continuing Welfare Drop-ins:**
 - Weekly casual chats in the Café or JCR
- **Good Lad programme:**
 - Workshops, tackling toxic masculinity, making people aware of micro-aggressions, how to avoid being a bystander
 - These should run alongside the other workshops given during freshers' week
- **Casual Study Groups**
 - Regular weekend study groups open to all
- **Library Sweep:**
 - Deliver sweets to anyone working late in the library, check whether they are okay!
 - This should happen throughout the year, not solely during exam term.
- **Mental Health Walks:**
 - Sunday afternoon/evening- break up the day. Get people outside.
 - The weekends, can in many ways, be the most difficult time of the week.
- **Charity events:**
 - Mental health formal working alongside other colleges
 - Possibly annual college rounders
 - Getting people involved, bringing people together.
 - Working alongside CALM (Campaign Against Living Miserably), who are supportive of events
- **Welfare Gardening**
 - Work alongside the Green Officer(s) to run a weekly therapeutic gardening session!
 - Making better use of the allotment
- **Raising awareness for eating disorders**
 - More information on the college website and around college on spotting the signs of eating disorders.
 - Tackling common misconceptions around eating disorders
- **Termly meetings with the Senior Tutor**
 - Push for the Senior Tutor to be more proactive when it comes to student welfare
- **Welfare Massages:**
 - In theory, this is a brilliant scheme, however there are a very limited number of spaces.
 - Make the scheme balloted rather than having a first come first serve basis
