Sport Clubs

No team sports are permitted. Fitz clubs, indoor and outdoor, have to be suspended (again).

Societies

The lockdown risk assessment system applies.

Use of the tennis court

The tennis court must close (again).

Use of the playing field (without going through a club)

You can use the playing field following the [lockdown social contact rules](#), i.e.:

- With **one** other person from outside your household, so long as you maintain social distancing
- With any others from your household, without needing to distance
 - If you do go on as a household, and you see the Groundsman, please proactively tell him that you are from the same household (and so intend not to distance).

Many pairs/ household groups can be on the fields at once, **so long as they do not mix.**

Only Fitz members are allowed to use the field. Do not bring visitors.

The Oxford Road Pavilion is completely closed. This includes the toilets and access to sanitiser.

Feel free to use the big football goal that is locked to the netting on the other side of the cricket square. Don't try to use or move any other goals- they're all locked and not for use.

The field will be locked at the main gate until at least 7:30am, so don't try to go down too early in the morning!
